Suggestions

- All about planning - - PLAN AHEAD! Lehigh wants to see you going abroad. Lehigh faculty will work with you to get what you need for graduation and for major credit.
- Hold HSS requirements and free electives – super easy to transfer!
- Marketing courses and Economics courses are transferable.
- Consider the credit system: differs for each country – find out ahead of time how much credit you will receive.
- Think about the school that fits and what you will get out of your overseas experience rather than the location.

Things to consider

- Three program models
 - Short-term programs through Lehigh (summer and winter) – with other Lehigh students, run by Lehigh faculty.
 - Semester/Year programs with American universities (i.e. Syracuse University in Madrid or IES Beijing)
 - Semester/Year programs with international universities (direct enrollment programs – i.e. University of Sydney, University of Manchester, Chinese University of Hong Kong)
- Which semester do I go abroad? There really is a range of opportunities. See what works with your specific major, class schedule, and host university offerings.
- Take into consideration the academic calendar year of the host university (i.e. in Australia their academic year runs February-July (Lehigh's spring semester) and mid-July-November (Lehigh's fall semester).
- Possible concerns: housing and interviewing for a summer job or internship

Cost

- Pay Lehigh tuition (Lehigh financial aid, scholarships and grants travel with you)
- Room and Board to host university – can be cheaper or more expensive
- Airfare
- Passport & student visa
- Independent travel
- Travel Grants are available for Asia and Exchange Institutions
- You can leave Lehigh University housing to go abroad and not be penalized with fees.

- Seeing the world outside American experience – gives you basis to evaluate your own experience
- Enhances cultural fluency
- RESUME builder – study abroad gives you a competitive edge
- Allows you to grow as an individual
