**First summer** classes begin Tue, May 26, and conclude on Wed, July 1, unless otherwise noted. No courses will meet on Monday, May 25 (Memorial Day). **To allow all courses to end on the same date and still have the proper number of meetings, there will be one make-up day on Fri, May 29 for courses that meet Monday and Wednesday (makeup for Memorial Day), and one make-up day on Fri, June 5, for courses that meet Tuesday and Thursday (makeup day for the 12th session that would have been July 2).** The exam dates are Thursday, July 2, and Friday, July 3.

**Second summer** classes begin Tue, July 7, and conclude on Wed, August 12, unless otherwise noted. **M/W classes do NOT meet on Mon, July 6. To allow all courses to end on the same date and still have the proper number of meetings, there will be one make-up day on Fri, July 10, for courses that meet Monday and Wednesday, and one make-up day on Fri, July 17, for courses that meet Tuesday and Thursday (makeup day for the 12th session that would have been August 13).** Exam dates are Thursday, August 13, and Friday, August 14.

University Commencement Day 2009 is Mon, May 18, 2009 and University Commencement Day 2010 is Mon, May 24, 2010. University Degree Awarded Dates are Sun, Sept 6, 2009; Sun, Jan 17, 2010, and Sun, Jan 16, 2011. For further explanation, please consult with the appropriate program staff.

The net **tuition** during the 2009-2010 academic year is **\$525** per credit hour, however, the tuition for the joint MBA/M.Ed. program in Ed Leadership is **\$605** per credit hour. **Intern and clinic supervision fees** are charged in addition to tuition. The **auditor's fee** is the same as the complete course fee. The non-refundable **application fee** for admission is **\$65**. There is no registration fee, however, depending on when you register, a **\$100 late course registration fee** and/or a **late payment fee of \$200 might be incurred** – please refer to the Bursar's Office website [www.lehigh.edu/~inburs/](http://www.lehigh.edu/~inburs/).
