Dr. Brad Cressman is currently employed as Professor of Practice at Lehigh University. In addition to teaching graduate courses in the College of Education at Lehigh, he is also the Executive Director of Lehigh's School Study Council. Before assuming this position, Dr. Cressman served as Superintendent of Schools for Northwestern Lehigh School District. Prior to his appointment as superintendent, he taught public school in Pennsylvania, served as Elementary School Principal, and Assistant Superintendent. Throughout his thirty one years in public education, he has served on various local and state education committees. Dr. Cressman earned his Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Lehigh University, a Masters of Science Degree from Temple University and a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Mansfield University.

Dr. Cressman has published his research on the Roles and Responsibilities of Superintendents and School Boards and is the co-author of "The Science Discovery Book", Scott Foresman & Company. Brad is also a frequent presenter at state and national conferences on topics focusing on curriculum development, the change process, and data-driven decision-making.
