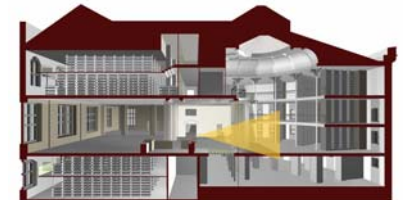

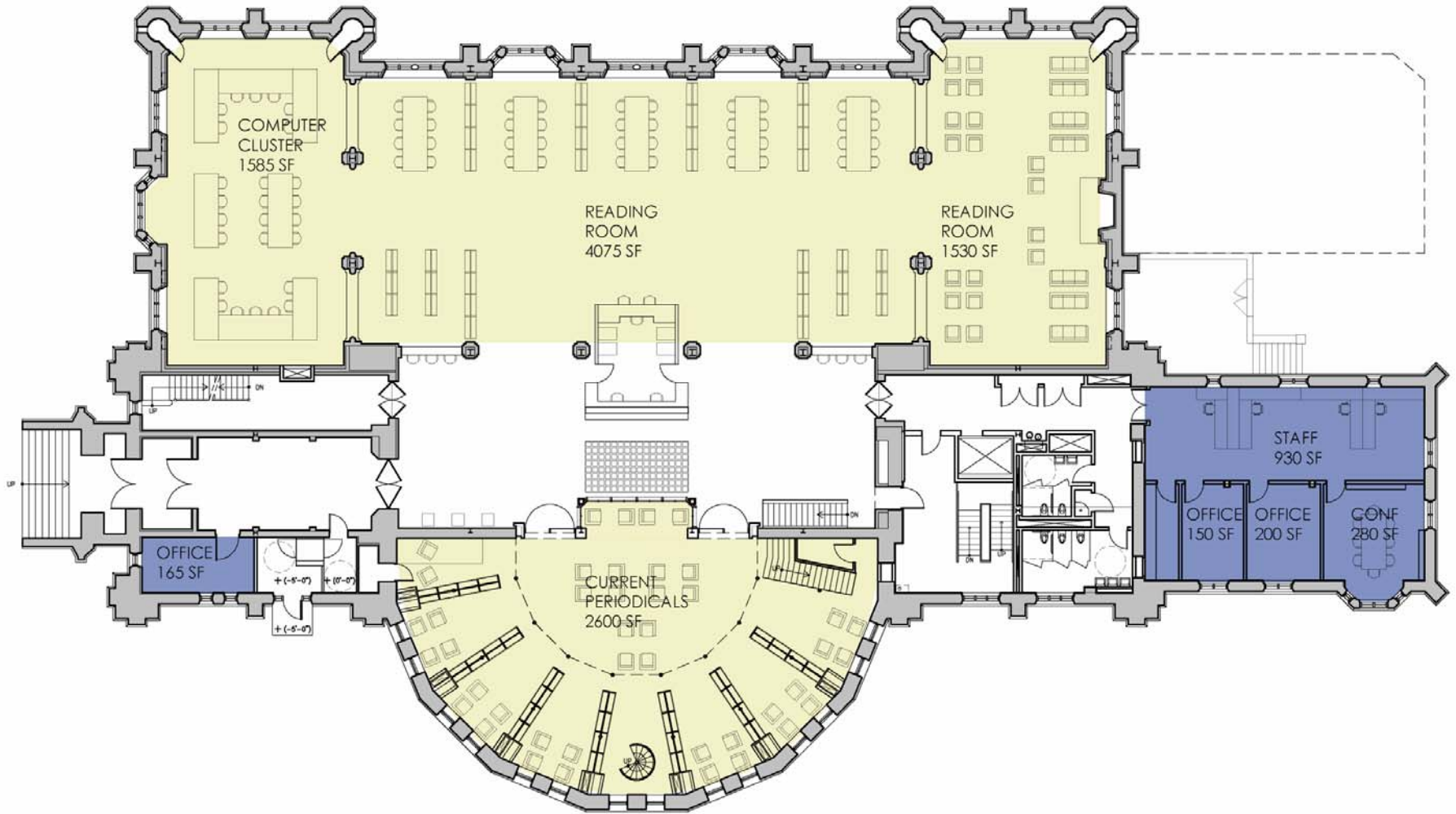
View from Reading Room toward Rotunda

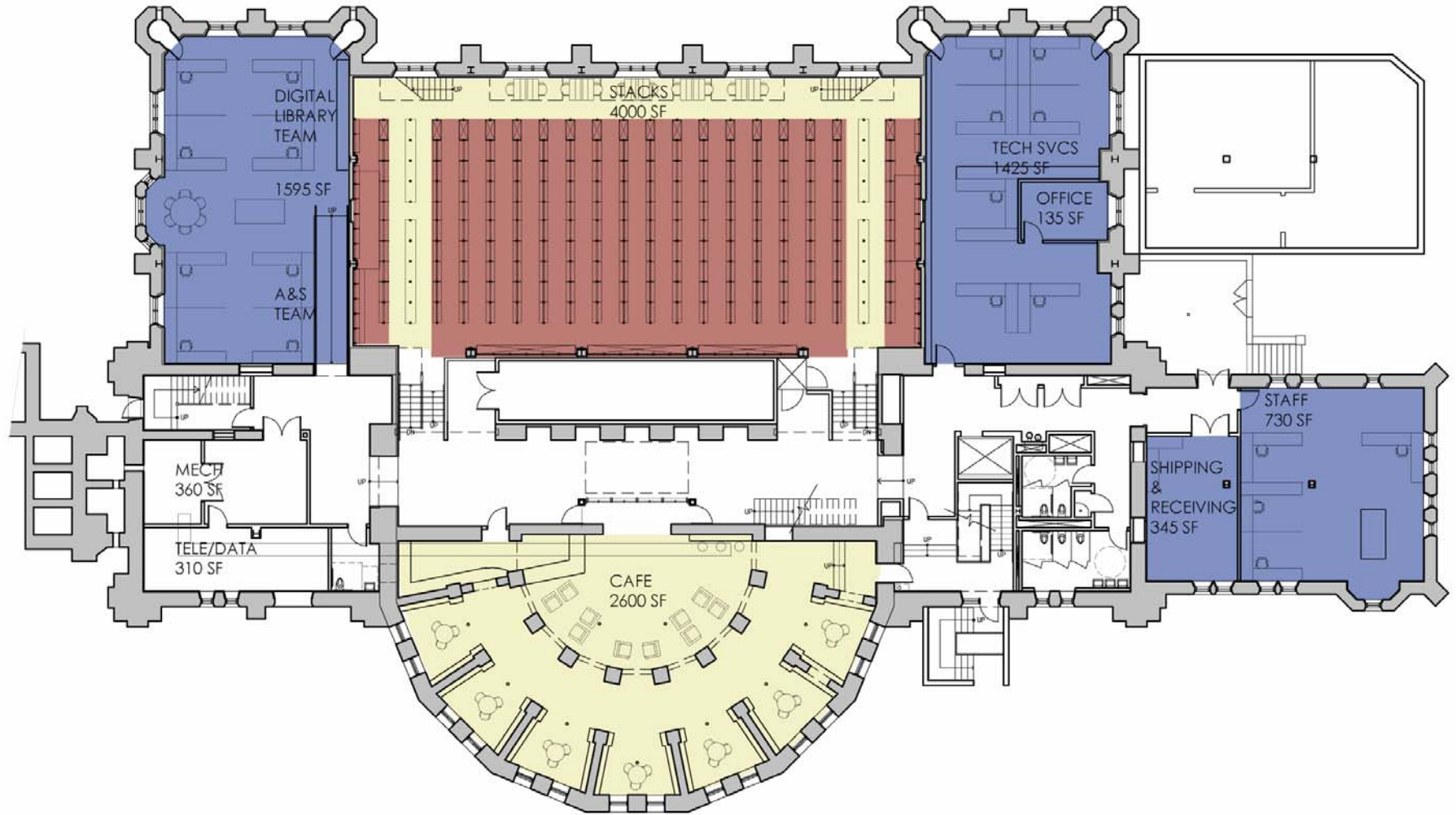


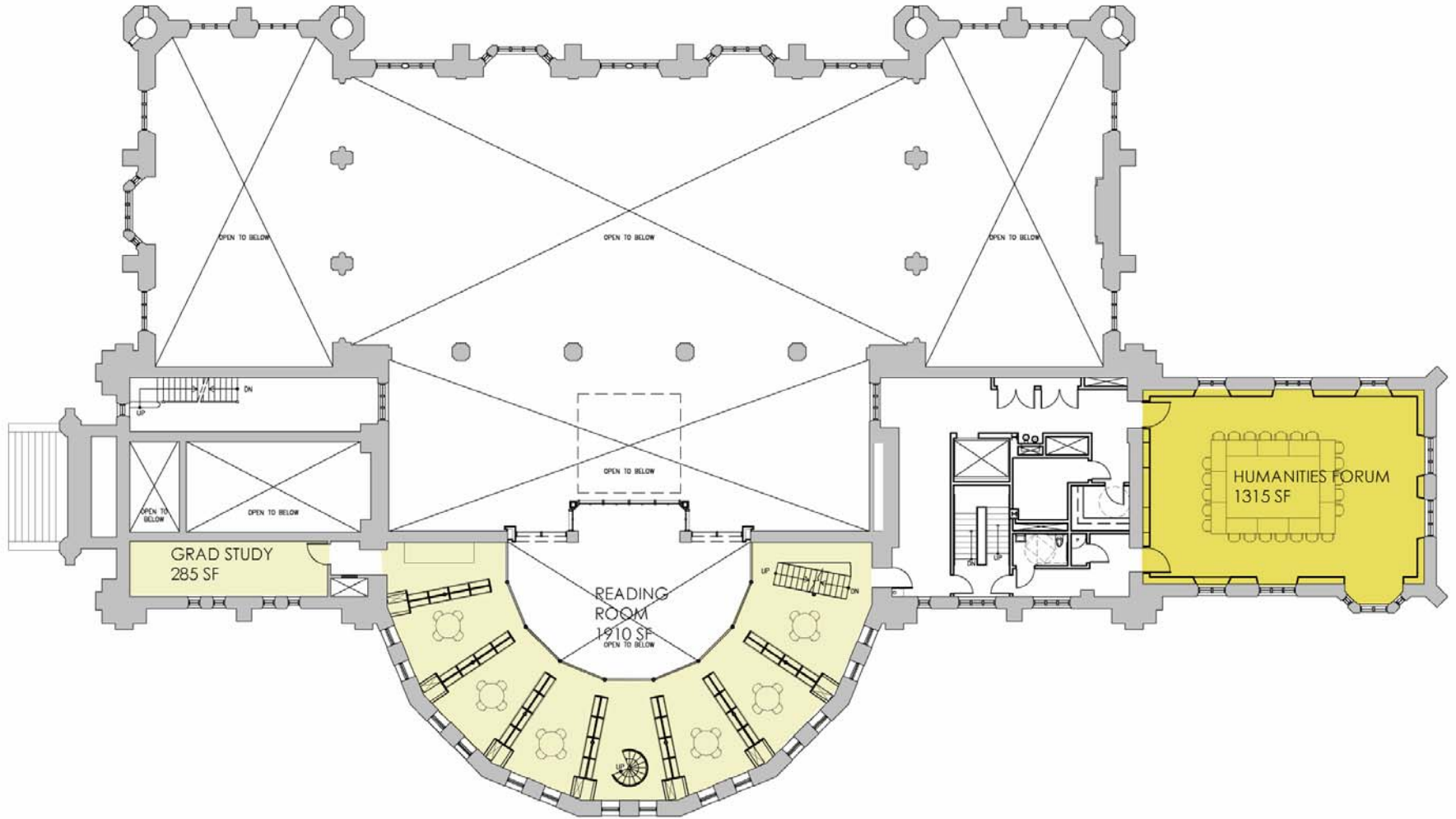


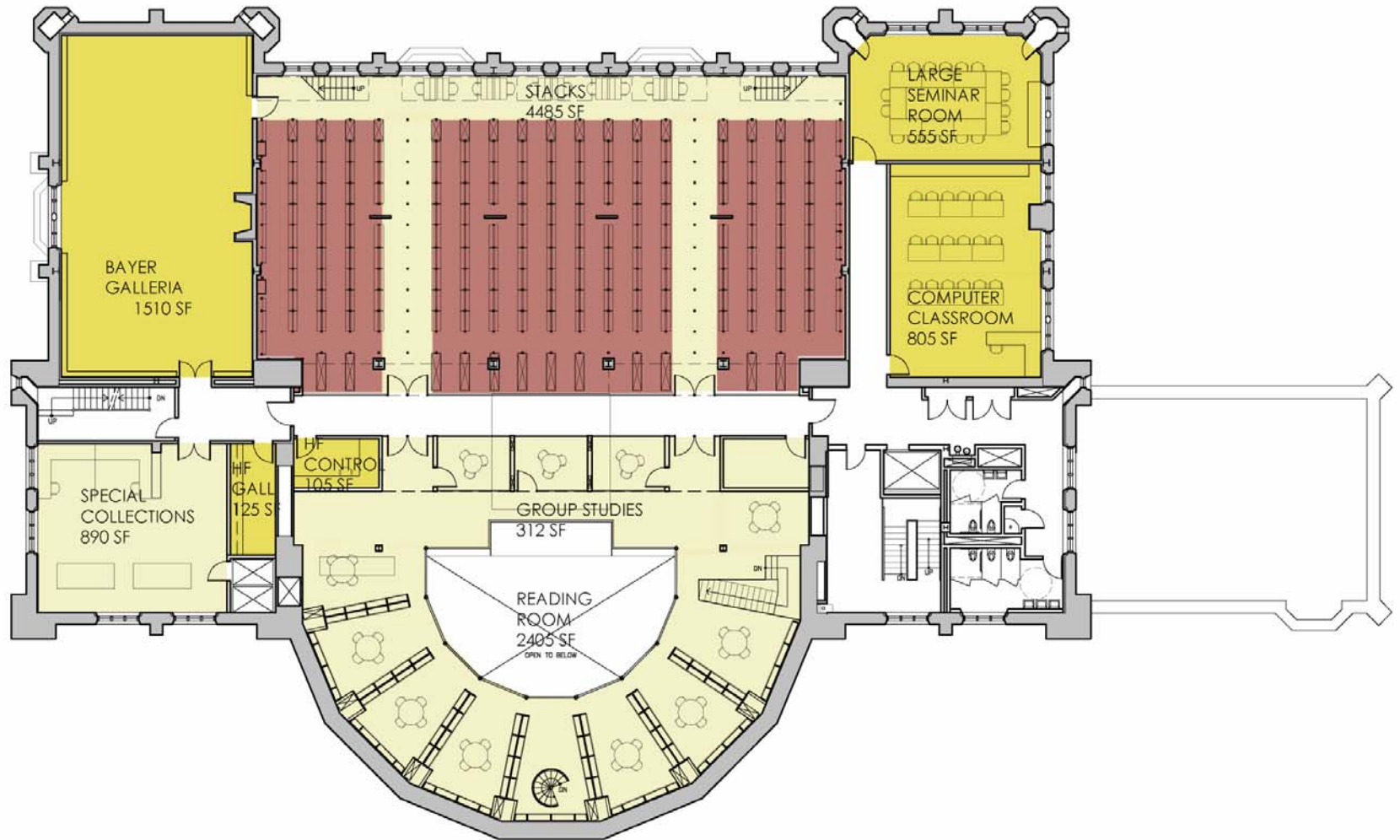
Inside the Rotunda Looking Out & Up

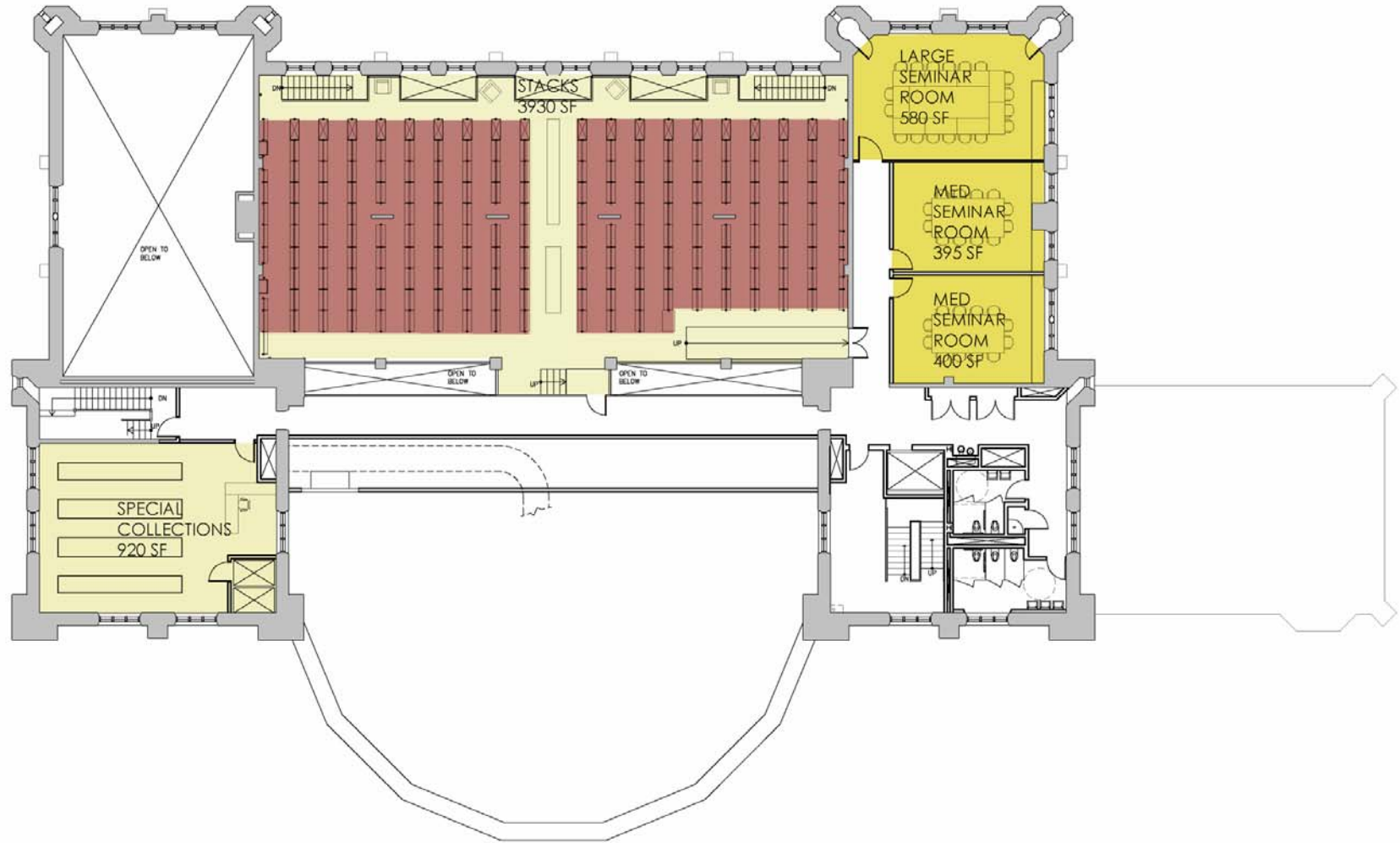


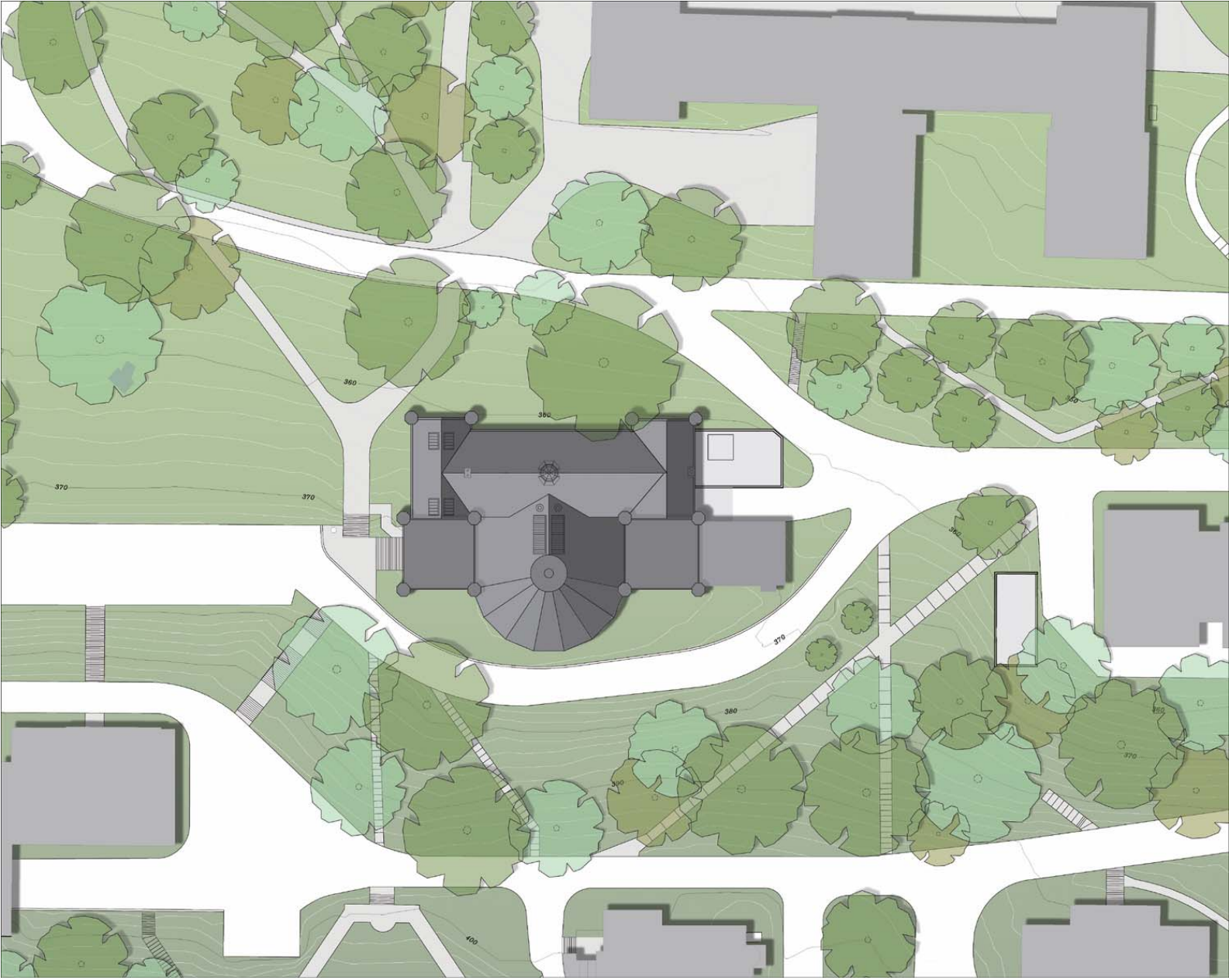
