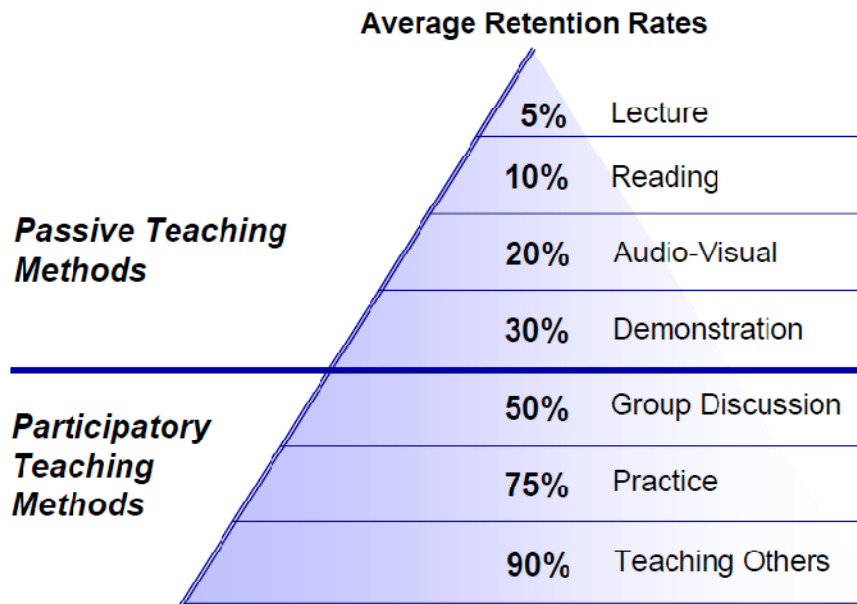


Active Learning & Retention

- Active learning is crucial for remembering information
- Students retain material better when teachers use more participatory methods in the classroom:



- College-level learning is highly self-directed
 - This means YOU get to pick the methods you use to learn new material
- **The more active your learning method—and the more you personally participate—the more you will retain!**

—TIPS—

- * Always take notes in class
- * Have study group members bring a list of questions to each session
- * Practice writing and answering problems or short essay questions
- * Pick a study partner and take turns teaching from your notes
