## NANO FOR BUSINESS 2010

**Greater Lehigh Valley, PA** — [Lehigh Nanotech Network](#) will host the **Nano for Business 2010** conference on May 26, 2010, at Lehigh University's Mountaintop Campus-Iaccoca Hall in Bethlehem.

This third [Nano for Business](#) conference will explore nanotechnology market trends, current commercial applications such as clean tech and life sciences, funding mechanisms, and partnering opportunities. The interactive event will provide a forum for business leaders to learn how nanotechnology can positively impact technology development and commercialization. The conference will feature speakers from industry, government and education. It will include focus groups in key areas such as alternative energy, health and safety, research and education resources, financing, training, workforce development and partnerships to help companies succeed.

Nanotechnology involves science and engineering at the molecular and atomic scale, with applications in areas such as life sciences, electronics and energy. [Lux Research](#) predicts that by 2015, revenue from products incorporating nanotechnology will total \$2.5 trillion. The Lehigh Nanotech Network, affiliated with the [Center for Advanced Materials and Nanotechnology](#) at Lehigh University, aims to broaden access to regional nanotechnology expertise and facilities and to encourage business/education collaborations and partnerships.
