The Philip and Muriel Berman Center for Jewish Studies, Lehigh University, Bethlehem, Pa., in cooperation with the Cardinal Bea Centre for Judaic Studies at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome seeks Visiting Scholar to teach at the Gregorian during spring 2010 semester.

Candidates should be prepared to introduce beginning graduate students of diverse cultural backgrounds to some area of Jewish History, Literature, Philosophy, or Culture, and to present one public lecture. (Ph.D. required. Teaching effectiveness is a priority.)

The Pontifical Gregorian University has about 3,000 students, graduate and undergraduate, from over 100 countries. A majority are enrolled in the Faculty of Theology and in related disciplines. Some, including members of different religious traditions (e.g. Muslims, Hindus), pursue a graduate degree in the Institute for the Study of Religions and Cultures.
