PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Summer Programs in Sustainable Development in Costa Rica

The Lehigh in Costa Rica Program has operated study abroad courses for over 14 years. The close association developed between Lehigh's faculty and a variety of Costa Rican NGOs has allowed us to expand our program to include two new sustainable development initiatives: 1) A five-week summer internship program, and 2) A summer environmentally-oriented community service project. Program Cost

- **Service Learning:** \$1,400 (includes airport transfers, home-stay, & local program transportation)
- **Internship:** \$0 – Preference will be given to students who meet the following requirements: 1) no previous experience on a Lehigh-sanctioned study abroad program 2) demonstrated financial need (3) Spanish proficiency 4) EES, ES or BIO major). Students will be notified if they are selected to receive this fellowship. Students not eligible for an Iacocca Fellowship may still participate on a cost-paying basis.
