Michael Ellis called the meeting to order at 9:05. He announced we are now officially a section, having been approved by the Division and APA. Regarding the status of officers, all offices are two years except Communications which is 3 years. We will hold elections in New Orleans at APA.

This is our first official meeting. We now have the \$400 allocation and need to determine the use of it.

**Possible uses** for the section allocation which were introduced were:

- Research award: supervision research needs a boost—it might be motivation for people –should it be pre- or post-dissertation?
- We could have poster presentations at social hour—students would submit to executive committee.  
Award of \$100 to student with best research –should it be completed or proposal
- Award for practitioner-researcher  
a committee could be set up to operationalize the plan for the Practitioner – researcher award.
- Focus on teaching of supervision—submit what one does in curriculum relevant to supervision
- Two student awards; one professional award  
Money to student; plaque to professional  
\$373 total may be allocated to students as money for travel
- One monetary award for a dissertation—a very special honor
- One award for \$100; \$200 for travel—
- Make it research award – not just supervision
- Best Practices award
