UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

- * **To the extent funding permits**, Lehigh University makes loans (maximum 6 credits per session) and student employment (maximum \$2,500) available for students during the summer. Students may be considered for loan assistance if they will be enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credit hours during the summer sessions (these credits can be taken in one session or three (3) credits in each session).
- * Eligibility is based on **financial need** and the **availability of funds**.
- * Applicants must satisfy the requirements for making "satisfactory academic progress."
- * Applicants must also have a CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application and FAFSA on file for the 2007-2008 academic years.
- * Applicants are encouraged to apply for any state and federal grant and/or loan funds for which they might be eligible.
- * **Please be advised that your Federal Stafford loan eligibility, for the 2007-2008 academic year, will be reduced by the amount of any Stafford loan borrowed for the summer sessions. Stafford Loans may be processed on the basis of a minimum of 3 credits in each session, which is considered half-time during the summer.**
