- 1. To the extent funding permits, Lehigh University makes loans and student employment available for students during the summer. Students may be considered for assistance if they will be enrolled at least half-time during the summer term.
- 2. Eligibility is based on financial need and the availability of funds.
- 3. Applicants must satisfy the requirements for making "satisfactory academic progress" in order to be considered eligible for aid.
- 4. Applicants must have a completed CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE[®] and FAFSA application on file for the 2014-2015 academic year.
- 5. Aid eligibility is based on enrollment status. Students must notify the office of financial aid if there are any changes to the amount of credits for which they are enrolling in during the summer term.
- 6. Applicants are encouraged to apply for any state and federal grant and/or loan funding for which they might be eligible.
- 7. Please be advised that your Federal Direct loan eligibility for the 2014-2015 academic year will be reduced by the amount of any Federal Direct loan borrowed for the summer sessions. Federal Direct Loans may be processed on the basis of a minimum of 3 credits in each session, which is considered half-time during the summer.
