Tibet Revisited, 20 Years

Artist-in-residence Elaine Ling will offer a public lecture and visual presentation of her recent photographic work in Tibet, with special emphasis on Tibetan art. Ms. Ling will focus on the people, the culture the temples, Buddhism, and the landscape, relying on both black and white and color photography and a few short movies. Tibet Revisited follows pilgrims on their prostrating journeys along the mountain roads to the sacred temples, and witnesses the festival celebration of the yearly unfurling of the tungas--and reassures that Tibetan Buddhism is alive and well. This lecture is sponsored by the Visiting Lecturers Committee, the Lehigh University Art Galleries and Museum Operations, and ArtsLehigh.
