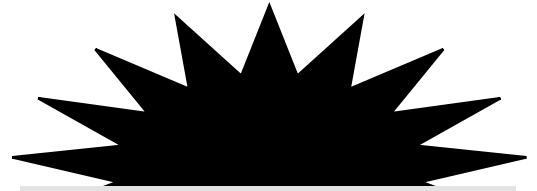

Two recent graduates of Lehigh University, Bethlehem received accolades for their contributions to Catholic Campus Ministry from the Newman Foundation at Lehigh at its annual Board of Trustees dinner May 10.

Mass was celebrated at the Doctors of the Church Chapel in the Newman Center for living and deceased benefactors.

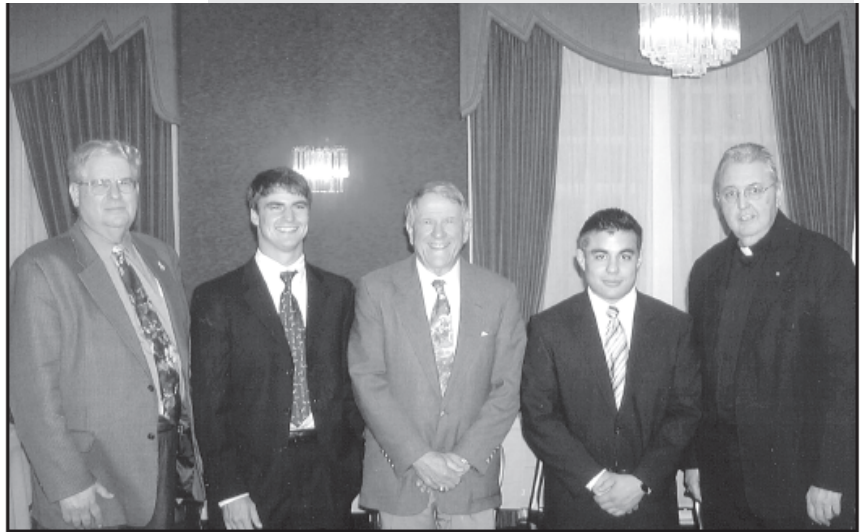
Celebrant was the Rev. Wayne E. Killian, Catholic Chaplain at Lehigh and Moravian colleges, Bethlehem and Diocesan Director of Catholic Campus Ministry. Concelebrating was the Very Rev. E.
