Our office was formed in 2001 and consists of two attorneys (Frank Roth and me) and one administrative professional (Elaine Kudella). We are here to provide legal advice to the University, which includes the Board of Trustees, officers, colleges, and academic and administrative departments. We provide legal advice to members of the University community solely within the context of the course and scope of their employment with the University. We offer legal advice in the following practice areas: contracts and business negotiations; litigation and dispute resolution; legal compliance, liability prevention, education and training; and University governance and policies. We cannot provide legal advice or representation to individual members of the University community with respect to personal matters or personal legal issues.
