

Physics 31: Information about the exam

There will be an exam in class (9:10 – 10:00 am) on Monday April 5, 2004. The exam will be closed book, but you may bring one sheet of notes, size 8 ½ by 11 inches, written on both sides. In addition, you may bring the sheet of notes you prepared for the first exam. If you did not keep that first sheet, you may bring an additional new sheet. The exam itself will contain the tables of Fundamental Constants, Particle Masses, Conversion Factors, and Useful Combinations of Constants from the inside front cover of the book, and the Mathematical Relations from page A-4, as well as the integrals from Appendix 6. Therefore, you do not need to write any of that information on your sheet of notes.

You should bring a calculator.

The exam will cover chapters 4, 5 and 6 through section 6.6, and homework sets 6 – 8.
