



Chain-like structure of ZrF_4 -based HMFG




First order IR spectra of HMFG


First order IR spectra of HMFG

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
Boson peak (IRO)

HMFG





Decoupling of tetrahedra.


Molecular model


First order polarized Raman spectra of ChG: identification of NBS (S_{nb}) atoms
