## **Submit Parent(s)' 2013 Federal Income Tax Returns.**

Submit copy of parent(s) 2013 Federal Income Tax Return along with all accompanying schedules & W-2 forms.

If parent(s) are not required to file a 2013 Federal Income Tax Return, indicate this on the Lehigh University Application for Financial Aid.

Families who file an extension with the IRS should submit a copy of their extension request & W2 statements to be followed by the completed form when available.

## **Submit Student's 2013 Federal Income Tax Returns.**

Submit copy of 2013 Federal Income Tax Return along with all accompanying schedules & W-2 forms.

If student is not required to file a 2013 Federal Income Tax Return, indicate this on the Lehigh University Application for Financial Aid.

## **2014-15** Business/Farm Supplement (*If Applicable*).

- Complete and submit if either parent is self-employed or an owner (part or full) of a corporation/partnership.
- Attach copies of the business tax returns (Schedule C, Corporate Tax Returns and/or Partnership Tax Returns).

# **2014-15** Non-Custodial Parent's Statement & Income Information (*If Applicable*).

- Complete and submit if biological parents are not married, and custodial parent is not remarried.
- Attach copy of Non-Custodial Parent's 2013 Federal Income Tax Return with all accompanying W-2 forms and schedules.

#### Reminder:

- All application materials must be complete and submitted by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- You must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress to maintain aid eligibility.
- Changes to your household size and number of siblings in college will affect your eligibility.
- A Change of Financial Circumstance Form can be submitted along with application.
