Subject: Information Requested

For most co-op participants, the amount of income earned during your co-op is considerably greater than what you would normally earn through summer employment. The increased earnings will not affect your financial aid eligibility until the next academic year, when the current years' tax returns will be used.

It is understood that you will experience increased costs for living expenses during this period.

To ensure the proper treatment of your earnings we are providing you with the attached *Income/Expense Budget form*. This form will help us better determine your actual savings for educational expenses upon your return and should be submitted with your application for Financial Aid for the next academic year.

Maintaining this log should be a relatively simple task, and may become a regular routine after graduation.
