Understanding Named Scholarships

Lehigh's generous donors established more than 1,000 scholarships so students are able to attend Lehigh regardless of their financial situation.

These donors are successful alumni and friends of Lehigh who have worked hard and who proudly give back to ensure your academic success.

Lehigh packages financial aid awards based on student need, and at first your package is sourced from general university grants. The Office of Financial Aid then determines the specific funding sources for your award based on your eligibility. The amount awarded through named scholarship(s) fund a portion or your total need-based Lehigh grant.

For most named scholarships, all students with aid packages are automatically considered. Selection is based on a student's match with a scholarship's criteria, if applicable.

A named scholarship does not change the total amount of financial aid awarded.

Your donor provided the funds for the scholarship, however they did not select you as the recipient of this award. Selection is facilitated by the Office of Financial Aid.
