On behalf of Lehigh University Transportation and Parking Services, I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Lehigh. This is an exciting time for you and your family and we wish you all great success.

Since first-year students are not permitted to have cars during their first year at Lehigh (with the exception of those who commute daily from home), we wanted to share with you Lehigh's transportation resources on campus.

Lehigh's Transit System for faculty, staff and students:

- <u>Campus Connector:</u> Transports students and faculty/staff to and from the Saucon Village, Goodman, Mountaintop and Asa Packer campuses.
- Packer Express: Transports students and faculty/staff around the Asa Packer Campus.
- Goodman Express: Transports students and faculty/staff to and from Saucon Village to Goodman to Asa Packer Campus.
- <u>Mountaintop Express:</u> Transports students and faculty/staff directly to and from the Asa Packer campus and Mountaintop campus.
- <u>Saucon Express:</u> Transports students and faculty/staff from Saucon Village to the Goodman and Mountaintop campuses
- <u>AccessLU:</u> Provides mobility transport services (scheduled and on-demand) to students, faculty/staff and visitors.
- Schedules of all Lehigh University bus routes and operation times are available on our website, <u>transportation.lehigh.edu</u> and we provide real-time tracking of all buses at <u>bus.lehigh.edu</u>. Students can also track buses on their smartphones using the free HawkWatch App, or by downloading the DoubleMap app (available at: Google Play or Apple App Store)

Public Transportation - FREE:

Public transportation schedules are available on the Lehigh and Northampton Transportation Authority website, www.lantabus.com. Lehigh provides students, faculty and staff with free rides on all LANTA buses. The Bethlehem bus terminal (at Broad & Guetter Streets, just north of campus) makes it convenient to commute home during breaks.

Parking Policies:

Since Lehigh is located in a residential area and parking on campus is limited, following our parking policies is essential. Parking areas are specifically assigned to various groups and all cars must be registered with our office. Please be advised that those who violate the "first-year student restriction" are subject to additional penalties including, but not limited to, suspension of parking privileges for subsequent years. Parking Services appreciates your cooperation with our parking policies.

Parking for Visitors:

If you are expecting a visitor, please obtain a temporary permit from our office at 622 Brodhead Avenue, prior to your visitor's arrival. Visitor permits for Friday after 4:00 PM, Saturday, and Sunday may be purchased online at go.lehigh.edu/parking (with Lehigh username and password). Other visitor parking options include:

- 1. Pay-by-plate parking spaces which are paid for using the Passport Mobile app.
- 2. Pay-by-plate in the Zoellner Arts Center parking garage which can be paid for at the kiosk on level 1 or with the Passport Mobile app.
- 3. Pay-by-plate in the Mountaintop Visitor parking lot on the Mountaintop campus which can be paid at the kiosks or with the Passport Mobile app.
- 4. Text-to-Park in levels 2-6 of the Alumni Building Parking Pavilion for parking after 4:00 PM and on weekends.
- 5. Text-to-Park in levels 1-2 of the Farrington Square Garage for parking after 4:00 PM and on weekends.
