All student athletes who wish to attend a **home** athletic contest when admission is being charged (football, men's basketball, women's basketball and wrestling) can use their Lehigh I.D. card for free admission. They must enter through the special <u>student</u> turnstiles at Goodman Stadium, Grace Hall, and Stabler Arena. All other varsity athletic contests are free of charge. Call the Ticket Office (758-4305) if you have any questions. Please be advised that you must utilize your own Lehigh ID card. Improper use of another person's ID card will result in the card's confiscation.

Exceptions to the ID admission are:

1. Lehigh-Lafayette football game - a reserved ticket must be purchased before the game through your living group.

- 2. The Lehigh ID card CANNOT be used for:
 - a. Patriot League tournaments
 - b. EIWA wrestling tournament
 - c. NCAA tournaments

d. Other special athletic contests that are brought to the Lehigh facilities; for example, Harlem Globetrotters, NFL scrimmages, etc.

Complimentary Ticket Policy and Procedure

Complimentary admissions to team competitions are distributed in accordance with NCAA rules and regulations. **Varsity athletes in ticket-selling sports** (football, basketball and wrestling) will receive up to four complimentary tickets for home contests and two complimentary tickets for away contests. These complimentary tickets are not for resale. Only one ticket per guest will be issued.

1. See your coach prior to the event for the 'player comp form'. Print your guest's name(s) on the player comp form legibly. Reminder: A ticket cannot be left for a prospective student-athlete. A prospective student-athlete is one who has begun the ninth grade.

2. You **cannot transfer tickets from one player to another**. If a player is not using his/her tickets you can ask that player to place your additional guests' names on his/her ticket sheet. The ticket office will print out an alphabetical list for each event so it's easy for the guests to sign for their ticket. IF YOU WOULD LIKE ALL THE GUESTS TO SIT TOGETHER, PLEASE NOTE THAT ON EACH SIGN UP SHEET (i.e. 4 ticket under Jones, 4 under Johnson, note on Johnson's form, please sit with tickets left for Jones).

NO HARD TICKETS ARE ISSUED. A STUDENT MAY NOT RECEIVE PAYMENT OF ANY KIND FOR HIS OR HER COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS. A STUDENT MAY NOT PURCHASE TICKETS FOR AN EVENT AND RESELL THEM AT A HIGHER PRICE.

The institution is responsible for this administrative procedure, and your eligibility shall be affected by involvement in action contrary to the provisions of these rules. (i.e. receipt of more than the permissible 4 complimentary admissions or the sale or exchange of a complimentary admission for any item of value).

NOTES:

- 1. Please inform your **guest(s) they must present a picture identification** (i.e. driver's license) except for those under the age of 16.
- 2. Instruct guest(s) to look for the Lehigh "will call" table/turnstile at each event so they can receive their ticket stub and gain entrance to the facility.

- 3. Tickets will not be given out in advance. After signing for the ticket, the guest must immediately go through the gate/turnstile with their stub. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. Guests must sign after their name. Any guest whose name does not appear on the list <u>will not</u> be issued a ticket and must purchase a full priced ticket for the event.
- 5. Many of these procedures are mandated by NCAA Rules. Exceptions are not permitted.
