Lessons Learned

- Empowering faculty may be more time consuming up front but has greater long term effects on the use of resources
- Communication is very important, it's better to send an e-mail saying "Yes, we know there's a problem" then it is to hide and not acknowledge there is an issue
- Using stationery feature in Lotus Notes e-mail saves a lot of time when communicating frequent problems/solutions with faculty



Lessons Learned (cont.)

- Customizing is great, but it's not very scalable
- Course naming convention is important:
Department-number-section-semester
e.g. CHM-101-10-SP07
- Integration between offices, people and systems is vital -- (automation)
- A test server can be your best friend!
